Youth Scholarships will be awarded based on the results of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education Scholarship Score which is derived from a student's performance on the 2011 Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Public Exams.

What makes you eligible for a Youth Scholarship?

To be eligible for Newfoundland Labrador Housing's Youth Scholarship Program, your legal guardian(s) would have to be either:

- 1) renting from Newfoundland Labrador Housing, and their signature(s) appear on the rental lease;
- 2) receiving a rent supplement from Housing;
- 3) receiving a mortgage subsidy from Housing, and their signature(s) appear on the mortgage document; or
- 4) living in Co-op housing or Community-Based housing which is being subsidized by Newfoundland Labrador Housing and their signature(s) appear on the occupancy agreement or lease.

You must also meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1) graduating from the Newfoundland and Labrador high school system in the current school year (June 2011);
- 2) attending a program of studies at any approved post-secondary education or career training institution on a full-time basis in the fall of 2011.

NOTE:

- 1) Information on the application form must be valid at the time the application is reviewed for eligibility.
- 2) Should you change post-secondary institutions after you submit your application, please contact Housing at 724-3003 to have your application updated.

REMEMBER:

To be considered for a Youth Scholarship, you only need meet the criteria listed above, then fill out and mail in the application.
